## **Application Package**

Do you have experience working with First Nations, Inuit and Métis youth? Are you interested in science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) education? Do you like to travel, learn from different people and places, and facilitate community engagement? Are you resilient, skilled at problem solving and able to go with the flow?

Would you like to combine these interests and skills to provide meaningful experiences for youth in rural, remote and Indigenous communities? If your answers are "yes," Actua's instructor team might be for you! Actua, a leading Canadian STEM outreach organization, is looking for instructors for the spring & summer of 2025.

The deadline to submit applications is February 7, 2025, 11:59pm ET.





### **Position(s) Overview**

### **Positions Available**

- Actua Instructor School Workshops
  - Classroom workshops for youth in grades K 12 (May early June)
- Actua Instructor Outreach Camp
  - Week-long STEM day camps for elementary-aged youth (end of June mid August)
- Actua Instructor Land Camp
  - STEM activities at overnight, on-the-land camps for high-school-aged youth (end of June - mid August)

### **Duration**

Variable term contracts (Maximum 16 weeks)

### **About**

Actua's instructors are post-secondary students, recent graduates, or individuals with equivalent experiences that have a strong interest or background in STEM, education, and/or working with youth.

As the instructor team primarily engages youth from Indigenous communities, Actua strongly encourages applicants who are living in or are from Indigenous communities or those with experience and/or knowledge of Indigenous cultures to apply.

### Actua is looking for applicants who are...

- Resourceful, flexible and adaptable to a variety of work conditions.
- Able to build positive connections with youth, co-workers, and community members.
- Strong public speakers who can communicate effectively with a variety of different audiences.
- Team players who understand the importance of working together towards a common goal.
- Problem solvers who can think on their feet and come up with creative solutions.
- Enthusiastic about learning and engaging with youth.



### **Key Aspects of the Actua Instructor Positions**

- Delivering fun, hands-on, educational STEM programming for youth.
- Serving as a positive role model for youth and an ambassador for Actua in Indigenous, rural, and/or remote communities during the entirety of your time in a host community.
- Maintaining an inclusive and safe space for ALL youth and team members.
- Participating in and/or coordinating community engagement activities.
- Working and living in a team environment with one to two co-instructors under minimal supervision in rural and remote communities and sites during your employment with Actua.
- Daily program management and administration.
- Assisting with program promotion and participant registration in communities.
- Corresponding with Actua staff members in Ottawa regularly during your employment.
- Travel
  - Managing personal and equipment logistics related to travel, including moderate to heavy lifting of supply bins.
  - Frequent travel to Indigenous, rural, and/or remote communities, with the majority of travel being via aircraft, driving in a vehicle, or travel by boat.
  - Ability to travel frequently and be on the road for the **duration** of your employment with Actua.
  - Comfortable staying in a variety of accommodations, including small hotels, homestays, tents and cabins.
  - Comfortable staying in shared living and sleeping quarters with another instructor for the duration of the work term.
- Contributing to the program's future development by participating in evaluation, providing feedback, and sharing stories.



### Compensation

- Salary:
  - Actua Instructor School Workshops: \$950/week
  - Actua Instructor Outreach Camp: \$950/week
  - Actua Instructor Land Camp: \$1050/week
- The difference in salary is reflective of the different roles and responsibilities an Outreach/School Workshop and a Land Camp instructor have during their work term.
- Actua covers or reimburses all work-related travel, expenses and accommodations, including the initial travel to training in Ottawa and your travel back home at the end of your work term.
- Actua provides per diems in addition to salary to help offset the higher food prices while instructors are in remote regions and are required to purchase their own food.

### **Qualifications**

### Highly desirable experience or skills include:

- Knowledge or experience of Indigenous culture(s) and/or are from an Indigenous community.
- Experience working in rural or remote communities.
- Experience working with an Actua Network Member program.
- Pursuing or background in a STEM discipline or other applicable field.
- Experience working with Indigenous youth in a camp or other informal educational setting.
- Experience travelling
- For Land Camp instructors, experience working with youth in an overnight camp setting.
- Ability to speak multiple languages, e.g. Inuktitut, Inuinnaqtun, Cree, other Indigenous languages, or French would be an asset
- A Valid 'G', Class 5, or equivalent driver's license, eligibility to rent a car, comfortable driving in various road and weather conditions, and an Actua sufficient driving record.
  - Note: You do not need to be a driver to apply for either position, however, Actua does have more positions available for drivers than non-drivers.



### Required qualifications/skills:

If hired, you must provide the following documentation to Actua before your work term begins (you do not require them to apply):

- Minimum Age
  - Actua Instructor School Workshops: Be at least 18 years or older at the start of the work term
  - Actua Instructor Outreach Camp: Be at least 18 years or older at the start of the work term
  - Actua Instructor Land Camp: Be at least 21 years or older at the start
    of the work term (there is a requirement for a minimum of 3 years
    difference between Actua instructors and the oldest participants in the
    programs).
- Be currently attending or have completed post-secondary education <u>or</u> provide information showing equivalent educational or lived experiences.
- Be able to participate in moderate to heavy lifting of program equipment for the duration of the work term.
- Have Standard First Aid and CPR C Certification.
- Clear Criminal Record check including vulnerable sector check.
- If hired as a driver, Actua will require you to submit additional screening.

\*\*Actua is available to assist successful candidates in obtaining the documentation and training requirements listed above. If any of the above are a barrier to you applying (i.e. no access to First Aid courses in your location), please let us know.
