About the Role:

- Duration: May 20 to August 30.
- Schedule: Full-time, Monday to Friday, 8:30 am 4:30 pm.
- Themes: Camps cover topics like Art in STEM, Stop Motion Animation, and STEM in Sport.
- Training: May and June focus on training and delivering in-school STEAM experiences.

Travel:

- Travel will be compensated, except for commutes to:
 - STEAM PEI's home base at 141 Mount Edward Road, Charlottetown, PE C1A 5T1.
 - Regular camp locations at Holland College in Charlottetown or Summerside.
- In some cases, accommodations may be provided.

Compensation:

- \$18-20/hour for post-secondary STEM students with relevant experience.
- Hours: Average of 37.5 hours/week.
