STEAM PEI is looking for **Summer Makerspace Support** to work with our team in developing and facilitating summer programs at the **Etl-kisite'tasik Makerspace**. Our priority is to create an **inclusive**, warm, welcoming, educational, and fun space for everyone.

What kinds of things will you do?

- Organizing and facilitating workshops, classes, play invitations, and special events for youth ages 3-18.
- Monitoring and supporting visitors during open Makerspace times.
- Learning and teaching others how to use specialized equipment such as 3D printers, laser cutters, vinyl cutters, and robotics.
- Processing retail sales and collecting and tracking payments for the use of the space.
- **Promoting, marketing,** and building awareness.
- **Keeping the space tidy** for visitors.

Summer hours for the **Etl-kisite'tasik Makerspace** are planned to be:

Monday to Friday: 9 AM - 5 PM

Saturday: 10 AM - 4 PM
Sunday: 12 PM - 4 PM

These hours are **subject to change** based on our summer visitor traffic.

Compensation:



- \$18-20/hour for a post-secondary STEM student with relevant experience (37.5 hours/week).
- \$16-17/hour for a responsible high school student in Grade 11/12 or recently graduated.
